Studio

The LAI document you can hand to your board, on a topic you define now.

Describe the document you need in plain language; Studio builds it from the Vectora LAI dataset, every claim traceable to its source.

— Ask in plain language. Get a document you can defend.

You describe the document you need in plain language. A planner negotiates the scope with you (entities, period, angle), then checks the dataset is actually rich enough to answer **before a single word is written**. If it is not, Studio says so, rather than inventing a confident page. Generation then runs as **retrieval-augmented generation (RAG)** over a curated LAI corpus, so every sentence is grounded in a retrieved, cited source rather than free-written. The result is a PDF or slide deck with a **sourced annex behind every claim**.

— From a plain-language request to a sourced document

Three steps, the way you would brief an analyst:

-  **Describe.** Ask for the document in natural language, the way you would brief a colleague.
-  **Scope & check.** The planner sets the exact scope and verifies the dataset covers it, honestly flagging any gap.
-  **Generate.** A sourced PDF or slide deck, with every figure and quote traceable to its origin.

Two output families: **Briefs** (one entity or one question, 1 to 10 pages) and **Reports** (multi-entity, thematic, 20 to 50 pages).

— What your team does with it

Business development

Walk into a meeting with a pre-meeting brief on the target: pipeline, recent deals, technology positioning, built in minutes rather than days.

Corporate development

Produce a quarterly state-of-LAI report for your board, grounded in the same facts every quarter.

Strategy & analysis

Get a thematic brief on a sub-segment you define, removing the hours of assembly a junior analyst would otherwise spend.

— Why you can trust what you read

- ✓ **A completeness gate that refuses to fabricate** if the dataset is thin on your scope, Studio tells you instead of guessing.
- ✓ **Every claim links back to its source** the document holds up under questioning, in a board room or an investment committee.
- ✓ **The same numbers as Atlas** one source of truth, no conflicting figures across your tools.
- ✓ **Grounded, not free-generated** retrieval-augmented (RAG) over a curated LAI corpus and the analyst's ontology, so every passage traces to a real source.

Delivered as a PDF or slide deck. A sourced annex sits behind every claim, so the document is defensible.
